Paris Patla Physical Therapy	\$100,000	Evaluate the effectiveness of commonly delivered clinical interventions and develop and evaluate the effectiveness of innovative interventions. Inclusion of cost-effectiveness preferred.
Acute Care	\$40,000	Studies must be directly related to acute care physical therapy and relevant to acute care in addressing one or more priorities in APTA's Research Agenda.
Cardiovascular and Pulmonary	\$40,000	NEW: Undertake diagnostic, prognostic, rehabilitative or therapeutic interventions or practices that will decrease cardiovascular disease risks and improve cardiovascular and pulmonary outcomes.
Education	\$40,000	Research methods for promoting the uptake of research findings into physical therapy or physical therapist assistant education and design educational interventions to address the gap between evidence and practice.
Foundation	\$40,000	Emerging investigators evaluate the effectiveness of interventions in any relevant physical therapy discipline.
Geriatrics	\$40,000	Address a high-impact priority for improving physical therapy treatment practices for aging adults consistent with the priorities in the APTA Academy of Geriatrics Research Agenda.
Moffat Geriatrics	\$40,000	Evaluate the effectiveness of physical therapists' examinations and/or interventions in geriatric populations.
Orthopaedic Physical Therapy	\$40,000	Emerging investigators explore clinical outcomes of physical therapy practice for patients with musculoskeletal conditions.
Pelvic Health	\$40,000	Advance pelvic health physical therapy, which covers abdominal and pelvic concerns of individuals across the gender spectrum and lifespan.
Snyder	\$40,000	Emerging investigators research the effectiveness of clinical physical therapy services and the development of new interventions that will be relevant and effective.
